

Agency Builds New Residential Home



The new English Road Residence is under construction. The staff and nine residents hope to move in at the end of the year.

Important Agency News In this issue, you will read that long-time Agency President, Paul C. Scott, has announced his retirement. As Paul opens a new chapter in his life, we will be celebrating the many accomplishments of our leader who was first introduced to the Agency 45 years ago as a summer employee. Paul has often said, "Mary Cariola is never far from my heart." We all would agree!

We thank Paul for more than three decades of dedicated service to Mary Cariola Children's Center and are proud of the many accomplishments that have happened on his watch. These include . . .

- The growth of our School Program.
- The development and creation of our Transition Center.
- The increase in the number of residential homes.

Paul has guided us through recessions and an increasingly regulated financial and service care industry. Always with calmness and consistency; he has touched all of us with his devoted grace.

Thanks to the generosity of Agency donors with assistance from New York State's Office for People with Developmental Disabilities, Mary Cariola Children's Center is building a new residential home for nine children and young adults currently living at the English Road Residence.

Groundbreaking took place last month. The new home will be constructed on the same 12-acre lot where the current home is presently located. That home, built in 1959,

was purchased by the Agency in 1981 and served residents who were non-ambulatory.

“The population served at English Road back then is not the same as it is today,” said Agency President Paul Scott. “We now have young adults who have more sensory and behavioral needs. The home will be built with that in mind.”

The new home is 4800 square feet and each resident will have his/her own bedroom. The home will be wheelchair-accessible and will include a living room and activity area. This will allow residents the option of playing computer or board games in the activity room, or enjoying some down time in the living room. Office space for residential staff, activities coordinators



State for a number of years to acquire funding for the home,” Scott said. “The condition of the house had captured the attention of the

local DDSO (Finger Lakes Developmental Disabilities Services Office) and that helped get the project back on track. We are fortunate and very thankful to get the approval when we did. It’s expensive and rebuilding doesn’t happen very often.”

The Agency’s 2008 Capital Campaign, under the direction of long-time Agency Board Members,

critical roles in the project. Trevor Harrison of HBT Architects and Malinda Gaskamp of Stantec Consulting Services provided generous pro bono work during the planning phase and offered expert advice to Mary Cariola’s Building and Facilities Committee.

The Agency used the Bailey Road Residence design as inspiration for the new English Road home. Since Bailey Road was the first residence the Agency built from the ground up, it provided many ideas that were incorporated into the new home.

“We learned that from a design perspective we needed to spread

and nursing staff will be in the finished basement.

Plans to build a new home had been in the works for a long time but State budget cuts had stalled the project and additional revenue streams had to be established.

“We had been working with the

things out," explained Anna-Lynn Brink, Director of Community Services. "Our new living room and recreational areas are on separate ends of the home and we created two bedroom wings to accommodate light and heavy sleepers. Most of all we needed more space for nine active residents."

The Agency's four additional residential homes in Rush, Henrietta, Perinton and Penfield have all gone through renovations or additions in the past. Thanks to an ongoing mechanical assessment plan, each home is routinely reviewed for necessary repairs or enhancements.

The new English Road home was designed by HBT Architects and will be built by The Buckley Group. Stantec Consulting Services provided the land development surveys. The residents hope to move into their new digs by the end of the year. •

Annual Giving Sets Record!

Mary Cariola's 2011 Annual Giving Campaign has been the most successful in Agency history. The direct mail campaign launched in November and netted \$115,000 for the Agency.

"We wanted to share stories of our students in hopes they would inspire our Agency friends to contribute . . . and they did," said Brad Pearson, Director of Agency Advancement. "Mary Cariola is still facing some difficult funding cuts and the money raised from this appeal will help bridge the gaps," he said. "Every gift represents a donor who believes in our students and our mission. That means the world to us."

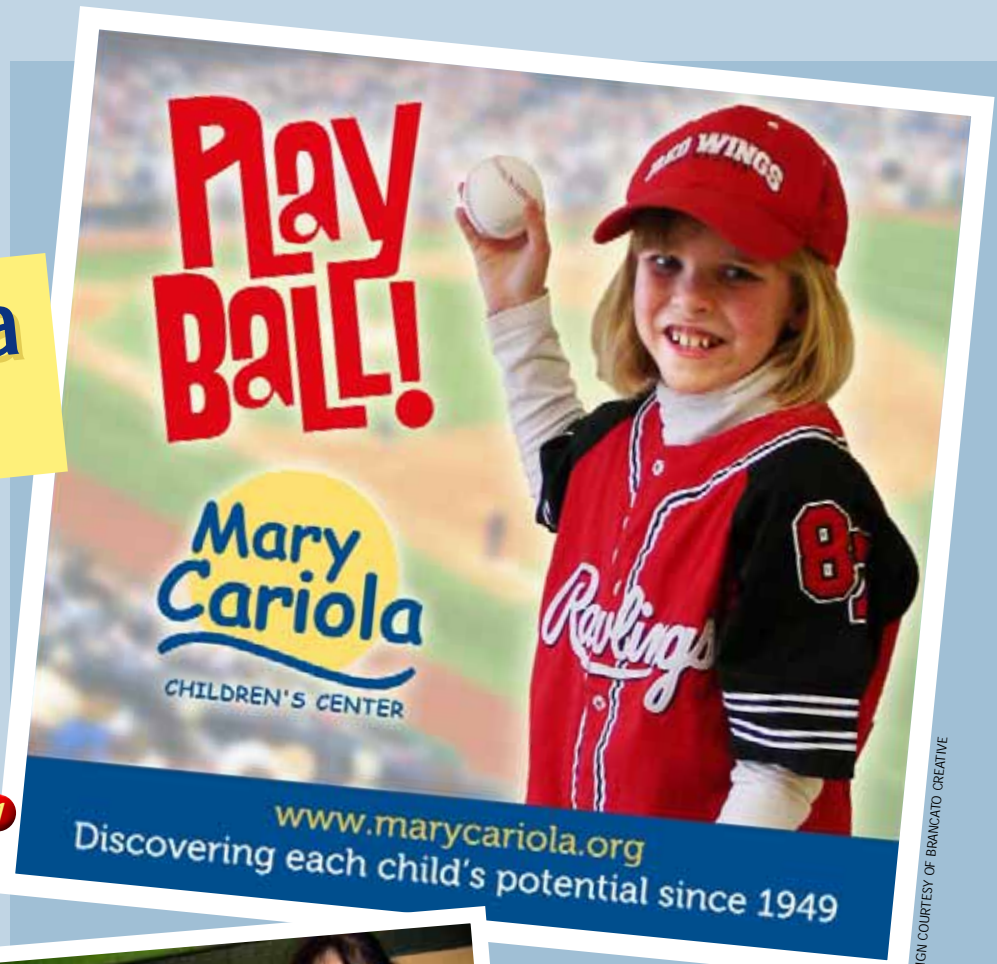
